Notice to Claimants' Counsel

Re: Combustion Engineering 524(g) Asbestos PI Trust
Approved list of land-based boilers

The Combustion Engineering 524(g) Asbestos PI Trust has published a revised approved list of land based Combustion Engineering ("CE") boilers containing asbestos for use by claimants filing claims with the Trust. The revised list is posted on the Claims Information page of the Trust's website at www.cetrust.org.

The Trust last updated the list in August 2008. Since then, the Trust has obtained over 900 boxes of documents from CE and Connecticut Valley Claim Service Company. The documents include CE boiler databases and summaries of CE boiler contracts prepared by a CE engineer and company historian. The Trustees retained the services of Rob St. Jean, formerly of Connecticut Valley, and tasked Mr. St. Jean and Verus with reviewing these documents, and reporting to the Trustees.

Based on the review and report by Mr. St. Jean and Verus, the Trustees identified 1,140 sites of land based CE boilers containing asbestos in the United States and 67 sites of land based CE boilers containing asbestos in Canada which were not on the list. The Trust revised the list to include those locations.

The study revealed 123 duplicate entries on the list of land based CE boilers. The Trustees have revised the list to eliminate these duplicate entries.

As a result of the study, the Trustees also determined that 120 sites on the original list do not have asbestos-containing CE boilers. The CE boilers at those sites were constructed and installed after CE discontinued using asbestos. The Trustees have removed those sites from the approved list. The removed sites may be reviewed on the Trust's website. If you have evidence that a CE boiler containing asbestos is located on one of the removed sites, please provide that evidence to Verus.

From the documents obtained from Connecticut Valley and CE, the Trustees have also determined the presumptive earliest dates that a CE boiler containing asbestos was constructed and/or installed at each of the sites on the list. The Trustees have added the presumptive earliest dates that an asbestos-containing CE boiler would be at each particular site to the list. The Trustees also presume that the asbestos-containing CE boiler remained at each site on the approved list, absent evidence to the contrary.
