Notice to Claimants' Counsel

Re: Combustion Engineering 524(g) Asbestos PI Trust  
Approved list of Vessels containing CE Boilers

The Combustion Engineering 524(g) Asbestos PI Trust has published a revised approved list of Combustion Engineering ("CE") Vessels containing asbestos for use by claimants filing claims with the Trust. The revised list is posted on the Claims Information page of the Trust's website at [www.cetrust.org](http://www.cetrust.org).

The Trust last updated the list in August 2008. Since then, the Trust has obtained over 900 boxes of documents from CE and Connecticut Valley Claim Service Company. The documents include CE documents, databases and summaries of CE vessels prepared by a CE engineer and company historian. The Trustees retained the services of Rob St. Jean, formerly of Connecticut Valley, and tasked Mr. St. Jean and Verus with reviewing these documents, and reporting to the Trustees.

Based on the review and report by Mr. St. Jean and Verus, the Trustees identified 1,700 vessels that are either new vessel listings (56) or (1,644) alias names of vessels that have been listed on the original list.

The study further revealed 114 vessels that have been removed from the original approved vessel listing, including (28) duplicate entries on the list of CE Vessels, and (86) vessels removed based on contracts involving nuclear power or non-asbestos related contracts. The Trustees have revised the list to eliminate these 114 entries. A listing of the 114 vessels removed is listed on the Trust website.

As a result of the study, the Trust approved vessel list now contains 3,884 entries. The original list contained 2,300 entries. If you have evidence that a CE Vessel containing asbestos is located on one of the removed sites, please provide that evidence to Verus.

From the documents obtained from Connecticut Valley and CE, the Trustees have also determined the presumptive earliest dates that a contract for a CE boiler was installed on a vessel. The Trustees have added the presumptive earliest dates that an asbestos-containing CE boiler would be on each particular vessel on the list. The Trustees also presume that the asbestos-containing CE boiler remained on each vessel on the approved list, absent evidence to the contrary.
